



Unique Personal Identifier – Client Registry

Center/Institute for Health Information

A provincial Center/Institute for Health Information wanted an application that would link health information held in various systems throughout the province in order to increase integration and collaboration.

The Unique Personal Identifier (UPI) client registry project was launched to provide individuals with a once in a lifetime number, either at birth or upon moving to the province. Every person accessing the health system will have a UPI (a database of numbers creates the Client Registry) which contains demographic information accessible only by authorized users. UPI/Client Registry provides accurate client information, improves client care, and removes the need for repetitious collection of demographic data.
