MD Office Gateway allows physician practices and satellite offices to connect to external stakeholders such as hospitals, labs, pharmacies and other doctors. The solution also enables the relay and receipt of information to and from medical devices that are capable of generating clinical data. Cloverleaf technology integrates different healthcare applications and enables real-time sharing of data among them; supporting an effective information exchange throughout the healthcare organization and its various IT systems.

xwave will build the interfaces that connect these systems with the Cloverleaf infrastructure, thereby making them accessible to MD Gateway users. xwave will also market the MD Office Gateway solution in Canada via the firm's extensive healthcare-practitioner base. Through MD Office Gateway, xwave will provide physicians with a robust, integrated system that requires minimal hardware and that facilitates the automatic update of patient data through a hospital or province-wide electronic medical record.

“Interoperability is fundamental to the successful adoption and use of healthcare IT,” said Gary Folker, managing director, Clinical Management System, xwave. “If we are to fully take advantage of our collective investments in information technology, we must effectively connect the information-keepers with one another.
